

Pensacola Junior College Student Ambassador Program

HOW...

How would you like to be a part of a program where YOU represent PJC and everything it has to offer? Each year students are chosen and trained to be a part of this special program. Student Ambassadors represent PJC at various events on and off campus. These activities may range from College Night, Honors Night, graduation, campus tours and high school recruiting visits. The goal of the program is to enhance College recruitment and retention by providing students with the best resource the College can offer- other successful students.

IF CHOSEN....

If you are chosen to be an ambassador you will be provided with training that will enhance your leadership abilities, increase your interpersonal communication skills and obtain opportunities that strengthen public speaking. You will be provided with a PJC polo shirt, emblazoned with the Student Ambassador logo and Student Ambassador Nametags. Students receiving other stipends from PJC organizations for service hours (e.g., SGA) are not eligible to be Student Ambassadors during the same term. Student Ambassadors are paid minimum wage on a bi-weekly basis. You will have the opportunity to make up to \$1,000 for the year. If you are currently working as a student assistant in a department on any of the campuses, you may continue to do so. The Pensacola Junior College rule limiting you to 20 hours per week is waived for Student Ambassadors.

REQUIREMENTS...

Enrolled in no less than 6 credit hours per fall and spring semester

Enrolled in no less than 3 credit hours for the summer semester

Maintain a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA **and maintain a semester GPA no lower than 2.5**

Represent PJC as an ambassador at two major college events per semester and assist with peak registration times, in addition to other duties as assigned

Names of three references from PJC or high school faculty, staff/administration, employer or community member

Reliable transportation

Attend required training

Serve a minimum one year term
