**What is the HESI-A2 Admissions Exam?**

The HESI Admission exam is required for admission to the Registered Nursing Program. It evaluates general knowledge in areas of Math, Reading Comprehension, Vocabulary and General Knowledge, Grammar, Chemistry, Anatomy and Physiology (A & P), Biology, Physics, Learning Styles, Personality Profile and Critical Thinking.

**When are the HESI-A2 exams held?**

HESI exams are held on specific Fridays throughout the year and are available only for students with an application to PJC on file. The exam begins at 8:00 A.M. and students have up to 7 hours to complete the test. See the [Testing and Assessment Center](#) main web page for hours of operation.

**What is the cost of the HESI-A2 exam?**

The cost of the exam is \$70.00. **Testing fees are non-refundable and non-transferable to another date.** If you miss your scheduled test date you must reschedule and pay the test fee again.

**What is the Retest Policy?**

Students who want to retake the HESI-A2 test must wait 6 months to retest, pay the testing fee and reregister.

**How do I register for the HESI-A2 exam?**

You must pay the test fee (\$70.00) before registering for the test. The test fee can be paid at the Pensacola, Milton or Warrington campuses Bursar's Office. Registration is only available, in person, at the Test Center, Pensacola Campus. Please bring the following items with you when you register:

- Paid receipt
  - Government issued photo ID
  - Your Pirate email address
